HOW TO CLEAN VENETIAN BLINDS

Tools & Materials Needed:

- A. Clean cloths
- B. Vacuum cleaner
- C. Soft bristle brush
- D. Two clean buckets
- E. Gloves and goggles

Products:

1. Cleaner disinfectant

Procedures:

- I. Purpose of Cleaning Venetian Blinds
 - A. Remove dust and dirt from vanes of venetian blinds where bacteria can multiply.
- II. Weekly Procedure for Cleaning Venetian Blinds
 - A. Adjust the blind to expose the flat surface.
 - B. Vacuum entire exposed surface from top to bottom using a left to right motion as you clean.
 - C. Reverse the flat surface of the blinds and repeat the procedure.
 - D. Return the venetian blinds to original position.
- III. Monthly Procedure for Cleaning Venetian Blinds
 - A. Put on gloves and goggles.
 - B. Using a clean cloth and cleaner disinfectant in a bucket, clean the blinds from top to bottom, working in a left to right motion as you clean.
 - C. Rinse cloth frequently in clear water.
 - D. Dry the surface of the blind with another clean cloth.
 - E. Reverse blinds and repeat procedure.

- F. If possible to remove blinds from window, an alternate procedure is recommended.
- 1. Remove blinds.
- 2. Soak in cleaner disinfectant.
- 3. Agitate with a soft bristle brush.
- 4. Rinse with clear water.
- 5. Dry and rehang.
