## HOW TO ROUTINE CLEAN A LAUNDRY

#### **Tools & Materials Needed:**

- A. Vacuum with hospital grade filter, dusting tool
- B. Deck brush
- C. Mop bucket with wringer
- D. Clean cloths
- E. Wet/dry vacuum
- F. Pump up sprayer
- G. Trigger sprayer
- H. Clean bucket for rinse water
- I. Gloves and goggles

### **Products:**

Cleaner disinfectant

### **Procedures:**

- I. Purpose of Laundry Room Cleaning
  - A. To prevent possibility of cross contamination.
    - 1. The laundry is a central location for linen that gets redistributed throughout the facility.
- II. Procedure for Cleaning the Laundry Room
  - A. Daily procedures
    - 1. Put on gloves and goggles.
    - 2. Empty waste receptacles.
      - a. Tie liner and dispose of properly.
      - b. Spray with disinfectant from trigger sprayer, inside and out.
      - c. Wipe dry with a clean cloth.

- 3. Damp dust with a cleaner disinfectant sprayed on a cloth. Rinse used cloth in clear water, reapply disinfectant to continue. Areas to clean are:
  - a. All sills and ledges
  - b. Outsides of machines and loading doors
  - c. Tables for folding linens
- 4. Vacuum floor surface to remove all lint.
- Using a deck brush and water from the mop bucket, remove any accumulations of soap on the floor surface.
- 6. Damp mop floor with a cleaner disinfectant. Pick up solution with a wet/dry vacuum.
- B. Weekly procedures
  - 1. Wash walls completely.
    - a. Fill pump up sprayer with diluted cleaner disinfectant.
    - b. Spray walls from bottom up.
    - c. Wipe walls dry.
  - 2. Clean all overhead pipes with vacuum dusting tool.
  - 3. Wash all linen carts.
    - a. Using trigger sprayer, spray all surfaces with cleaner disinfectant.
    - b. Let set.
    - c. Wipe dry.
- C. Periodic cleaning procedures
  - 1. Clean linen storage cupboards
    - a. Should be emptied and cleaned with a cleaner disinfectant occasionally.
