PATIENT ISOLATION ROOM CLEANING PROCEDURE

Tools & Materials Needed:

- A. Regular room cleaning tools and materials
- B. Personal protective gear
- 1. Special isolation insignia
- 2. Face mask
- 3. Rubber gloves
- 4. Protective gown
- 5. Over shoe protectors
- 6. Protective hat or cap
- C. Bag for collecting protective gear when finished

Procedures:

- I. Purpose of Isolation Room Cleaning Procedure
 - A. To prevent the cross contamination of bacteria from the isolation room with the rest of the facility.
 - B. Two types of isolation rooms exist.
 - 1. To protect non-patient personnel from the contagious disease carried by the patient.
 - 2. To put the patient into "protective isolation" to prevent infection coming into the isolation room.
- II. Procedures for Isolation Room Cleaning
 - A. Prior to entering the isolation room the housekeeping aide should:
 - 1. Wash hands thoroughly.
 - 2. Put on all protective equipment.
 - B. Before any necessary equipment is brought into the isolation room, it must first be damp disinfected.
 - 1. On exit from the room, the equipment must be damp disinfected a second time.
 - C. Follow the same cleaning procedures for routine cleaning of patient rooms.
 - D. When ready to exit room
 - 1. Remove all protective gear while standing just inside door.
 - 2. Place inside trash bag and seal.
 - 3. Step out of room.

- 4. Take trash bag for disposal or laundering.
- 5. Wash hands thoroughly.
