PROCEDURE FOR CLEANING THE GARBAGE DISPOSAL AREA

Tools & Materials Needed:

1. Cleaner Disinfectant
2. Garden Hose
3. Spartan Foamer
4. Deck Brush & Floor Squeegee
5. Stiff Push Broom
6. Gloves and goggles

Procedures:

During spring, summer and fall the odors in the garbage disposal areas become quite heavy from food, beverage and waste. The garbage disposal enclosure behind any food establishment needs to be cleaned and disinfected often. The use of the Spartan foamer with cleaner disinfectant will come in handy for cleaning this area when trying to prevent unsanitary conditions.

CLEANING PROCEDURES:

1. Put on gloves and goggles.
2. Sweep the floor area clean.
3. Fill foamer with cleaner disinfectant.
4. Connect garden hose to foamer.
5. Turn water on and form down the walls and floor of the garbage disposal enclosure.
6. Use a stiff push broom or deck brush to scrub down the walls and floor.
7. Foam down the walls and floor again.
8. Let set five minutes.
9. Rinse the area well and let air dry.
10. Clean and store all equipment.

CONCLUSION:

A clean and disinfected garbage disposal enclosure does not drive customers away, should they have to park near the enclosure. Fly and mosquito control will be cut in half when good cleaner disinfectants are used.
