PROCEDURE TO CLEAN AUTOCLAVES

Tools & Materials Needed:

- 1. Cleaner-disinfectant
- 2. Spray bottle
- 3. Wire brush
- 4. Clean cloths
- 5. Gloves and personal protective equipment

Procedures:

DAILY:

 Damp dust the outside of the autoclave with cleaner-disinfectant solution and a soft, clean cloth and wipedry to avoid streaking.

WEEKLY:

- 1. Verify that the autoclave has been turned off and has cooled. Remove all items that have been sterilized from the inside of the autoclave.
- 2. Using a narrow wire brush, remove all the debris and rust from the edges and grooves in the autoclave.
- 3. With the germicidal detergent solution, thoroughly wash the interior and exterior of the autoclave. Rinse all washed surfaces with clear water and wipe dry with a soft, clean cloth.
- 4. If the autoclave has removable grates, scrub with a wire brush and germicidal solution before replacing inside the autoclave. Rinse grate, wipe dry, and replace inside autoclave.

ADDITIONAL THOUGHTS:

1. Autoclaves are sometimes cleaned by Central Supply personnel rather than housekeeping personnel. Ask your supervisor if you are responsible for cleaning autoclaves.
